Oberg**, to the foregoing testamentary instruments, it appearing by such proofs that the same was/were duly executed and is/are genuine and valid and that the decedent at the time of executing the same was in all respects competent to make a will and not under restraint;

IT IS ORDERED AND DECREED that the instrument offered for probate herein be, and the same hereby is, admitted to probate as the Last Will and Testament of the above named decedent, valid to pass real and personal property, that the will and this decree be recorded and that Letters Testamentary issue to **JAMES M. WEISZ**, upon properly qualifying for such office.
